WE ANNOUNCE THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE DEATH OF OUR FOUNDER FR. JOSEPH DIACONO

He loved our Congregation so much and was eager to look well after our first Sisters and they cooperated, loved and listened to his teaching, beginning with our VenerableFoundress Mother Margherita.

Encouraged by their example, let us be brave and endeavour to follow his teachings and his counsels as a real spiritual Father of all of us. Truly many years have passed, but let us seek to adapt his spirituality and his teachings to the present times and signs, which our Congregation is going through.

I conclude with the same words of Fr. Joseph Diacono:

"Come on, therefore, dear Sisters in Jesus Christ, take heart and suffer everything for the One who, not only once sacrificed Himself on the cross, but every day He renews his sacrifice on our altars, offering Himself at the same time as food for your soul".
